Getting to the Natural History with public

Visitor Entrance:

Maria-Theresien-Platz, 1010 Vienna (near Burgring 7)

Easily accessible by public transport via: Subway lines: U2, U3 (Volkstheater station)

Tram lines: 1, 2, 46, 49, 71, D

Bus line: 48A"



Getting around in Vienna (Ticket Information)

PLEASE NOTE: A metro/tram (public transport – ticket <u>pricing</u>) ticket for Vienna does <u>NOT</u> include the area to the airport (so if you buy for example a single or 24/48/etc. ticket for your stay in Vienna, you need to pay an upcharge the S-BAHN etc. to the airpoirt.

Tickets can be bought at multilingual ticket machines (subway stations), most tabaco shops ("Trafik" in German), and via the Wiener Linien online shop: https://shop.wienmobil.at/de/products


IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR YOUR STAY IN VIENNA

Please note the following events taking place during your visit (find details in the links below):

13 June 2025 – <u>Pride Run Vienna</u> 14 June 2025 – <u>Vienna Pride Parade</u>

These events will involve road closures, particularly around the Burgring area, and are expected to cause significant disruptions to public transportation. We kindly recommend planning your travel accordingly and allowing for potential delays.

How to get from the Vienna International Airport, Schwechat (VIE) to Natural History Museum



By Train and Metro (Fastest and Most Convenient):

1. From Vienna Airport Terminal:

Take the City Airport Train (CAT) or S-Bahn S7 heading towards Vienna city center.

- o **CAT** takes about 16 minutes to Wien Mitte station (more expensive, no stops).
- \$7 is slower (~25 minutes), cheaper, and stops at multiple stations including Wien Mitte.

2. At Wien Mitte:

Change to the U-Bahn (subway).

Take U3 (Orange line) towards Ottakring.

3. At Volkstheater Station

Exit the metro here (this is the closest station to the Natural History Museum).

4. Walk to the Museum:

From Volkstheater, it's about a **5–7-minute walk** to the Natural History Museum Vienna, located at **Maria-Theresien-Platz near Burgring 7.**

CITY Airport Train (CAT)

NOTE: CAT is more expensive than the S7, this is why the platform for S7 is sometimes "hidden" after the CAT platform ... so you have to pass the CAT and go to the end of the platform if you want to use S7 as the cheaper version



- Take the <u>CAT</u> from Vienna Airport to Wien Mitte station (16 minutes, €12 for a single ticket)
- From Wien Mitte, transfer to the U3 (orange line) of the U-Bahn towards Ottakring
- Get off at Volkstheater station

Total time: ~35-50 minutes

Total cost: ~ 15 euros to get to Wien Mitte (with CAT) and then 2,5 or 8 euros (24 hours ticket)

Vienna Airport Lines (Bus)

VAL 1: Line VAL 1 line runs around the clock from Vienna West Station via Vienna Central Station (South Entrance) to Vienna Airport. The intervals are 30 minutes, except between 00:30 a.m. and 02:30 a.m. Between these times there is only one bus at 01:30 a.m.

Total time: ~20-30 minutes

Total cost: ~ 10 euros to get to Wien Westbahnhof (need to go by subway U3 from Westbahnhof in direction of Simmering then get off at Volkstheater).

TAXI

Option 1: Taxi Stands at the airport Option 2: Pre book an airport taxi via <u>link</u>

Total time: ~20-30 minutes, depends on traffic conditions

Total cost: ~ 40-60 euros (if you enter at the taxi stand ask in advance; also if payment is possible

via cash or card)
