



Submitted presentations

Abstract should not exceed 1 page typed in English Times New Roman, using Word for Windows. Replace the text in this template (https://www.13isowif.eu/submissions/) without altering the font, size, margins and basic layout. Abstracts may include figures and tables and should be submitted as a single A4 page only, using the downloadable template as a guide. Please use that template to create a PDF file (no larger than 250kb) for upload.

The deadline for submission is Friday May 23, 2025. The abstract can be submitted to nadia.piscopo@unina.it:

- There will be no resubmitting or editing after uploading.
- The papers must be submitted by the author who will present the work in Vienna, in compliance with the payment of the registration fee.

The title should not exceed 250 characters including spaces. Don't forget to include the details of each author. Equations should be centred and in italic:

Ekin=1/2mv²

References should be added in the text with superscripts.¹

Abstract should type in English Times New Roman, using Word. Papers should include: Title (Times New Roman font 12 bold, centered, maximum 250 characters); Names of authors (Times New Roman font 10 bold, centered); address of authors (Times New Roman font 10 italic, centered); Abstract (Times New Roman font 11, not exceed 300 words); Key words (Times New Roman font 10 italic, max 4 words); Introduction (Times New Roman font 11); Materials and methods (Times New Roman font 11); Results and discussion (Times New Roman font 11); Conclusions (Times New Roman font 11); Acknowledgements (Times New Roman font 10); References (Times New Roman font 10, Surname, Initial letter of name; year. Title. Journal, vol. (i), Pages. Alphabetical order).

Presentation of scientific works

The Scientific Committee will notify authors referee results after 2 weeks from the paper submission. Papers will be presented either orally or as poster, authors are required to give their preference. Seven minutes max will be allowed for the presentation of each paper. At the end of the session five minutes discussion period. Scientific Committee may decide on the type of presentation if needed and will notify authors accordingly.

Poster presentation: height 100 cm; width 70 cm. All posters should be mounted as soon as possible on Thursday, 12 June. All posters should be removed on Saturday, 14 June.

All abstracts will be submitted to "Acta Biologica Slovenica" for publication in a special issue of the Abstracts book. Later, full papers may also be submitted for publication for those interested.






